The following notification shall be published in the next issue of the Andhra Pradesh Extraordinary Gazette:

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub Rule (10) of Rule 74-A of Andhra Pradesh (Agricultural Produce and Livestock) Markets Rules, 1969 (As Amended vide G.O.Ms.No.38, Agriculture and Co-operation (MKTG-I), Dated: 10th May, 2016), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby appoints First day of January, 2020 as the date on which e-transport permit shall come into force and the existing export permit system stands discontinued w.e.f. 01.01.2020.

However, market fee payment in cash at the check-post is allowed upto 31.03.2020 and no cash payment of market fee at the check-post from 01.04.2020. Necessary operating procedure and guidelines will be framed by the Special Commissioner and Director of Agricultural Marketing, A.P., Guntur for effective implementation.

**C I R C U L A R**

Sub:- Agrl. Marketing Department – Agrl. Market Committees – Commencement of e-Transport Permit w.e.f 01-01-2020 – Notification – Orders issued by the Government – guidelines- Issued- Reg.

Ref:- G.O.Ms.No.112 A&C (Mktg-II) Dept. Dt.22-11-2019.

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The Government vide G.O. Ms.No.112 A&C (Mktg-II) Dept. Dt.22-11-2019 have issued notification that e-Transport Permit System shall come into force from 01-01-2020 and the existing permit system stands discontinued w.e.f. 01-01-2020. However, market fee payment in cash at the checkposts is allowed upto 31-03-2020 and no cash payment of market fee at the Checkposts from 01-04-2020.

Therefore, the following guidelines are issued for implementation of the e-transport permit system.

**Guidelines:**

- Every vehicle carrying notified commodities purchased by a trader shall be accompanied by an e-transport permit obtained from the designated online platform.
- The trader can generate permit using the trader's user id and password and the market fee for the permit can be paid on-line through Debit/Credit card or net banking to the designated account of the market committee at the time of generation of permit or in 7 days in respect of the permits used.
- The e-transport permit generated on the platform can be printed by the trader.
- e-transport permit being the proof of having paid the market fee, shall be adequate for allowing the transportation of the notified commodities covered by e-transport permit without attracting any further levy of market fee.
- Where the e-transport permit generated by the trader, there shall be one copy for the trader, one copy to accompany the vehicle and one copy for the market committee.
- The e-transport permit, accompanying the notified commodities, in transit shall be produced for inspection at the check-post or to the officer authorized to exercise the powers under rule 75 of (AP&LS) Markets Rules, 1969. Trader copy shall be retained by the trader which shall be produced at the time of assessment or during the inspection.
- In case of secondary sales by the traders, fresh e-transport permit can be generated by the traders selling the commodities and this e-transport permit shall be linked with the relevant previous e-transport permit(s).
- SMS with the details of e-transport permit generated on-line, will be sent to the mobile number of the trader/ commission agent which is the proof of having paid market fee for allowing transportation of the notified commodities covered by e-transport permit.
- Checkpost staff shall verify whether the vehicle transporting the notified Agrl produce, livestock and products of livestock, possess e-transport permit or not and they shall verify the validity period of the permit.
- Checkpost staff should scan the QR Code of the permit to avoid re-usage of the permit before expiry period.
- If the notified Agrl produce, livestock and products of livestock is moving without e-transport Permit, Compounding should be levied as per Section 23-A of AP(AP&LS) Markets Act, 1966.
- Compounding amount shall be paid by the traders through Credit card/Debit card or any other

electronic mode or through e-Pos machines maintained by the Market Committees for credit on-line into the PD Account of the respective Agrl. Market Committee. They shall not be allowed for payment in cash.

- However, market fee payment in cash at the checkpoints is allowed upto 31-03-2020 and no cash payment of market fee at the Checkposts from 01-04-2020. Cash receipt books (C.R) shall not be issued at the checkposts for collection of market fee from 01-04-2020.
- Teams shall be formed by the Asst Directors of Marketing in consultation with Joint Directors of Marketing for inspections and to supervise movement of vehicles transporting notified Agrl produce, livestock and products of livestock without valid e-transport permit. The teams shall be changed on rotation basis for every quarter or as per the need.
- The Joint Directors of Marketing and Deputy Directors of Marketing shall conduct surprise checks at least 10 days in a month covering all the districts in the region and Assistant Directors of Marketing shall cover all the AMCs in the District at least once in a month.
- All the middlemen doing business in villages without license, shall be issued licenses. If any person is doing business without license, the concerned Secretary and the Assistant Director of Marketing will be held responsible.
- Printed export permits issued by the market committees shall not be used by the traders w.e.f. 01-01-2020 i.e. from the date notified by the Govt for implementation of e-transport permit system.
- Un-used export permit books /permits as on 31-12-2019 shall be returned to the concerned Agrl. Market Committee by the traders. Secretaries should collect them from the traders.
- The secretaries shall obtain details of closing stock unsold with the traders as on 31-12-2019 with full payment of applicable market fee and furnish to Commissioner & Director of Agrl. Marketing for uploading to the e- transport permit application for generating permits.
- The Secretaries shall verify on-line, the monthly purchase turnover of the licensed traders through e-transport permits while considering the turnover for Assessment.
- The ADMs and JDMs shall arrange helpline phone numbers to assist the traders to redress the problems / issues that may arise in the implementation. The helpline phone numbers should be informed to all the traders and shall be displayed at the AMC.
